### PART 1 GENERAL

# 1.1 REFERENCE

.1 Comply with the General Conditions of the Contract, Supplementary General Conditions and the requirements of Division 1.

# 1.2 RELATED WORK SPECIFIED ELSEWHERE

- .2 Miscellaneous Metal Beam support Section 05500
- .3 Toilet and Bath Accessories Section 10800

## 1.3 SCOPE OF WORK INCLUDED

- .1 Supply and install Ceiling Mounted washroom toilet partitions as indicated on drawings.
- .2 Ensure structural is in place to support ceiling hung partitions.

### 1.4 SUBMITTALS

- .1 Submit shop drawings in accordance with Section 01340.
- .2 Clearly indicate fabrication details, plans, deviations, hardware and installation details.

# 1.5 PROTECTION

.1 Handling

Prior to installation, handle panels with extreme care, avoiding damage to the finished surface. Never slide one panel over another. Exposed top panel surface must be covered with heavy kraft or corrugated paper or cloth.

2. Storage

After delivery to the site, partitions and components must be stored in a dry area, protected against the elements and sudden extreme changes in temperature. Horizontal storage of panels supported on stringers at 24" intervals.

### PART 2 PRODUCTS

#### 2.1 MATERIALS

.1 Ceiling mounted toilet partition panels are to be manufactured from two sheets of panel flatness zinc coated steel Galvanneal ASTM A653, Laminated under pressure to a honeycomb core for sound deadening and rigidity. Formed edges to be welded together and interlocked under tension with a roll formed oval crown locking bar, mitred, welded and ground smooth at the corners. Honeycomb to have a maximum 25mm (1") cell size with compressive strength of 31 lbs per square inch.

Panels: Shall be  $25 \, \text{mm}$  (1") thick with cover sheets not less than 22 ga.

Pilasters: Shall be 32mm ( 1.25" ) thick with cover sheets not less than  $18~\rm ga.$ 

Base Bid Products: Hadrian Bobrick, Deco-Lam, General Partitions are acceptable alternates.

Finish: Colour paint match to Hadrian Colour Selector Guide:

### 3. Hardware:

- (a) Door hardware ZAMAC no. 5 zinc alloy with satin chrome finish unless otherwise noted.
- (b) Hinges gravity type, heavy duty.
- (c) Door Latch and Bumper Keeper Stainless steel with emergency access slide bolt type.
- (d) Coat Hook features a rubber bumper door stop located in all stalls.
- (e) Pilaster Saddles 18 gauge s.s.
- (f) Door Pull stainless for handicapped units.

Locate at height to satisfy NBC.

- 4. Support and mounting channels extruded anodized aluminum  $1 \, 1/8$ " x 3/4" in lengths to suit job condition.
- 5. Fasteners Stainless steel tamper proof type.
- 6. Note mounting of washroom partitions from steel beam that spans the opening of the washroom stalls. Butterfly mechanical fasteners inside the steel HSS is the propered method of securement.

### PART 3 EXECUTION

## 3.1 EXAMINATION

.1 Take field dimensions of Work upon which Work of this Section depends before fabrication. Field adaptation of Work fabricated in error or without field check will not be allowed without Consultant's approval.

## 3.2 INSTALLATION

- .1 Erect Work straight, plumb, level, and secured to prevent distortion or displacement or both.
- .2 Install partitions c/w anchorage of pilasters to support beams and walls, fastening of panels to panels or pilasters and to hanging of doors, bracing and specified hardware. Installation is to conform to manufacturers instructions.
- 3. Adjust all doors and hardware to operate smoothly.
