Add:	D23.	LIQUIDATED DAMAGES
Add:	D23.1	If the Contractor fails to achieve Substantial Performance in accordance with the Contract by the day fixed herein for Substantial Performance, the Contractor shall pay the City two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) per Calendar Day for each and every Calendar Day following the day fixed herein for Substantial Performance during which such failure continues.
Add:	D23.2	The amount specified for liquidated damages in 0 is based on a genuine pre-estimate of the City's damages in the event that the Contractor does not achieve Substantial Performance by the day fixed herein for same.
Add:	D23.3	The City may reduce any payment to the Contractor by the amount of any liquidated damages assessed.
Add:	D24.	PRIME CONTRACTOR – THE WORKPLACE SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT (MANITOBA)
Add:	D24.1	Further to C6.24, the Contractor shall be the Prime Contractor and shall serve as, and have the duties of the Prime Contractor in accordance with The Workplace Safety and Health Act (Manitoba).
Add:	D25.	WARRANTY
Add:	D25.1	Notwithstanding C13.2, the warranty period shall begin on the date of Total Performance and shall expire one (1) year thereafter, except where longer warranty periods are specified in the respective Specification sections, unless extended pursuant to C13.2.1 or C13.2.2, in which case it shall expire when provided for thereunder.
Add:	D25.1.1	For the purpose of Performance Security, the warranty period shall be one (1) year.

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Add: D25.2 Notwithstanding C13.2, the Contract Administrator may permit the warranty period for a

portion or portions of the Work to begin prior to the date of Total Performance if a portion of the Work cannot be completed because of unseasonable weather or other conditions reasonably beyond the control of the Contractor but that portion does not prevent the

balance of the Work from being put to its intended use.

Add: D25.2.1 In such case, the date specified by the Contract Administrator for the warranty period to

begin shall be substituted for the date specified in C13.2 for the warranty period to begin.
