- Q1 I would be very interested in what the City is paying under its current contract as it would at least present us with a starting point for providing a solvent solution.
  - A1 We are unable to comment on current pricing, as we have confidentiality obligations to our current contractor.
- Q2 City of Winnipeg did not put any number of units desired in this RFP. We can access the number on your webpage, but it doesn't state the current number active, the number of mobile units, or even how many units are ultimately expected.
  - A2 In accordance with Items 3, 31, 78 and 234 of Form N: Detailed Specifications indicates the number of ISC locations Cameras and Mobile units expected. Existing Sites, Cameras and mobile enforcement units are virtually the same as being requested in the RFP depending on repair and maintenance status.
