### PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise D9.1 to read:

The Contractor shall provide and maintain the following insurance coverage:

- (a) commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg added as an additional insured; such liability policy to also contain a cross-liability clause, **contractual liability, unlicensed equipment liability, (contractors equipment)** non-owned automobile liability and products and completed operations cover, to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work;
- (b) **if applicable**, Automobile Liability Insurance covering all motor vehicles, owned and operated and used or to be used by the Contractor directly or indirectly in the performance of the Service. The Limit of Liability shall not be less than \$2,000,000 inclusive for loss or damage including personal injuries and death resulting from any one accident or occurrence;

Revise D9.4 to read:

All policies shall be taken out with insurers licensed to and carry on business in the Province of Manitoba.

Revise D10.1 to read:

The Contractor shall report to the City any event resulting in injury or damage immediately following the occurrence of such event, and the receipt of notice of an action, proceeding, claim or demand alleging or giving notice of injury or damage immediately following receipt thereof, to the City of Winnipeg Claims Branch.

### PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

Revise E11.2 to read:

- V1 Sidewalk Snow Blowers Mounted on Skid Steer Loaders for bridges.
  - (a) Minimum 34", **Maximum 48"** cutting height approx. 30", minimum 270-degree rotation on discharge chute, full remote control from inside cab for chute while blowing snow.
  - (b) All controls to be mounted inside cab. All cabs shall be enclosed and heated.
