PART A – BID SUBMISSION

Replace: 306-2015 Bid Submission with 306-2015 Addendum 04 - Bid Submission. The following is a summary of changes incorporated in the replacement Bid Submission:

Form B(R1): Remove Item No. 1 – **This Contract will be solely for abatement and emergency services by a Contractor.**

PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise: B2.1 The Submission Deadline is 4:00 p.m. Winnipeg time, May 8, 2015.

PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D2.1 The Work to be done under the Contract shall consist of the **provision of services for asbestos abatement, with additional recommended repairs and emergency services** approved by the Contract Administrator, at all Winnipeg Transit facilities for the period from **June 1, 2015 until May 31, 2016**, with the option of four (4) mutually agreed upon one (1) year extensions.

Revise: D2.1.2 Changes resulting from such negotiations shall become effective on **June 1st** of the respective year. Changes to the Contract shall not be implemented by the Contractor without written approval by the Contract Administrator.

Add: D2.1.3 **This contract will be solely for abatement and emergency services, not inspections.**

Revise: D3.1 The Contractor shall perform the Work of this Contract during the period of June 1, 2015 to May 31, 2016, with the option of four (4) mutually agreed upon one (1) year extensions.

Revise: D9.1 (e) Certificates of insurance to indicate the Contractor's operations including asbestos abatement services.

Revise: D11.3 The City intends to award this Contract by June 1, 2015.

PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: E2.1

The Contractor shall perform any asbestos Work recommended by the Contract Administrator after annual inspections are completed, in accordance with a mutually agreed upon schedule, except in emergency. In emergency situations, Work shall commence within two (2) hours of the placing of an order, unless otherwise allowed by the The City at the time of ordering.
