1.0 DESCRIPTION OF EQUIPMENT

- 1.1 These specifications describe a Four Post Lift and other Equipment and features as specified herein.
- 1.2 The Four Post Lift shall be a new 2015 model year or newer.
- 1.3 The Four Post Lift and all other items/components shall be the manufacturer's latest models. The vehicle shall be furnished complete and ready for operation. Any parts or accessories not specifically mentioned, but which are required to complete and place the vehicle into successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications. The complete vehicle, and all parts thereof, shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship, to the best standards and engineering practice of the industry

2. OTHER SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS

- 2.1 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
