STEAMER BOILER

1.0 DESCRIPTION OF EQUIPMENT

- 1.1 These specifications describe a <u>Steamer Boiler</u> and other equipment and features as specified herein.
- 1.2 The **<u>Steamer Boiler</u>** shall be a new 2016 model year or newer.
- 1.3 The <u>Steamer Boiler</u> and all other items/components shall be the manufacturer's latest model. The equipment shall be furnished complete and ready for operation. Any parts or accessories not specifically mentioned, but which are required to complete and place the equipment and associated attachments in successful operation shall be furnished as though specifically mentioned in these specifications. The equipment and associated attachments, and all parts thereof, shall conform in strength and quality of material and workmanship, to the best standards and engineering practice of the industry.
- 1.4 It will be the responsibility of the Bidder to inform the City of any errors or omissions in these specifications, for under this Contract the Contractor shall be held responsible for the satisfactory operational function of the equipment.

2.0 OTHER SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS

- 2.1 All applicable SAE standards form an integral part of these specifications and shall have precedence in any conflict concerning minimum acceptable standards.
- 2.2 The <u>Steamer Boiler</u> shall comply with the applicable regulations: The completed equipment shall meet all City of Winnipeg and Federal Safety Regulations and the (CSA) Canadian Safety Standards Association. The steamer boilers shall be certified by the Manitoba Department of Labour if required.

Minor items or ordinary service adjustments are not included, or considered under the scope of "repeated failures", as well as other factors, such as operational damage due to accidents, misuse or lack of proper maintenance, service and lubrication attention by not following the manufacturer's preventative maintenance schedule.
- 7.3 Where the <u>Steamer Boiler</u> develops "repeated failures" in service, the Contractor shall make any necessary engineering changes, repairs, alterations or modifications in order to guarantee reliability of performance.



11.0 WARRANTY

- 11.1 All warranty information shall be detailed and include all exclusions. The successful bidder shall provide all published warranty information upon delivery of the equipment. Bidder shall state all warranty information.
- 11.2 The warranty for the Steamer Boiler shall cover the complete equipment, and all parts thereof against any defects of workmanship, construction and materials, for a period (1) one year, unlimited hours on complete unit, (3) three years on heat exchange coil no deductibles. Any article that has become defective during said warranty period and has not proven to have been caused by negligence on the part of the user shall be repaired or replaced at no cost to the City.
