Subject: Culvert Replacements, Truro Creek, Winnipeg (17-HCAA-01419)

The Fisheries Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada received your Culvert Replacement proposal on September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2017, which has been reviewed under the *Fisheries Act* and the *Species at Risk Act*.

The following aquatic species, currently listed under the *Species at Risk Act* is/are believed to use the area downstream of your project site:

- Bigmouth Buffalo, listed as Special Concern
- Mapleleaf mussel, listed as Endangered

Based on the information provided, your proposal has been identified as a project where a *Fisheries Act* Authorization is not required given that serious harm to fish can be avoided by following standard measures, and a Permit under the *Species at Risk Act* is not required. Your project, as proposed, is not considered to need an authorization from the Program under the *Fisheries Act* in order to proceed. In order to comply with the *Fisheries Act*, it is recommended that you follow our guidance tools which can be found at the following website (<u>http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/measures-mesures/measures-eng.html</u>). It remains your responsibility to meet the other requirements of federal, provincial and municipal agencies.
