QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q1 Will service resulting from this REOI cause the termination of any existing Wi-Fi agreements in place with the City?
- A1 Existing contracts, including Facility Access Agreements, will continue to be honored per contract terms. It is conceivable that certain technological limitations (e.g. wireless interference) may need to be addressed in association with all stakeholders.
- Q2 Could service resulting from this REOI be part of an existing contract or agreement the City may already have in place with a Vendor
- A2 Due to the particular specifications, terms and scope of this REOI, it is expected that any resulting Work will be under a net-new contract or agreement.
- Q3 Can a vendor choose to leverage its existing infrastructure in place today for delivery of this Wi-Fi service outlined in the REOI?
- A3 While *City*-owned infrastructure is not leverageable, a Vendor with existing infrastructure at a City location may opt to leverage or repurpose it for this use (should the Vendor ultimately be selected in a future Bid Opportunity)
- Q4 What monetary component can a vendor expect with this REOI ie. in terms of potential costs/sponsorships?
- A4 The City anticipates innovative and sustainable solutions that are beneficial to Consumers, City and Vendor alike, with no financial outlay from Consumers nor the City. All solutions aspiring to meet this goal will be considered.

Q5 A usage cap is not outlined in this REOI, does the City expect a limit on usage ie. 200M, 1Gig?

A5 The City expects unlimited usage within the limits of what is deemed to be acceptable use.

Q6 Does the City prefer to have one or multiple vendors offering Wi-Fi services with respect to this REOI?

A6 The City would prefer to deal with a single Vendor of record.
