QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1: Are any of the 125 Virtual Machines selected for this Disaster Recovery process running Windows Server 2008 SP2 or lower or Ubuntu 18.04 or higher?

A1: Win2008R2 -26 Servers; Win2003 - 1 Server; Ubuntu - 2 Severs

The city is in the process of upgrading the windows 2008 OS to 2016.

Q2: Are all of the 125 Virtual Machines selected for this Disaster Recovery process residing in the same or different VMware clusters (i.e. are they all managed by the same VCenter Server)?

A2: VMs are managed in two different VCenters located in 2 different datacenters. The city is planning to build two extra VCenters across existing 2 datacenters.

Q3: Of the 125 Virtual Machines selected for this Disaster Recovery process, how many are Windows based and how many are Linux based?

A3: Only 8 VMs are Linux based.

Q4: you indicate that the City is planning to setup a direct VPN from on-premises to Microsoft Azure - would this be Microsoft Azure ExpressRoute?

A4: The direct link will be a VPN.
