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#### **PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS**

- Add D10.5 In order to assure minimum downtime of the Equipment, the Contract shall maintain a stock of all replacement parts in North America, either in his/her own inventory or in that of an agency that normally supplies parts to the Contractor, for a period of five (5) years.
- Add D10.5.1 Further to D10.5, if replacement parts are not available within the five (5) years, and the City is required to build or acquire parts by their own means, the Contractor may be charged back 100% of the parts replacement costs.
- Add D10.6 Parts shall be made to the City of Winnipeg Transit, by the Contractor within three (3) Business Days from a request by the Contract Administrator or designate.
- Add D10.7 Where Equipment is not available for use due to the Contractor's failure to supply parts in accordance with D10.6, the failure to supply parts may be determined to be an Event of Default in accordance with C16.
