PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

WORK E3 Add

Add: E3.1 The area of Work is critical to the building operations and shall remain operational during construction. The Work shall proceed under the following constraints. Coordinate

timing with Transit at least 5 days in advance of work:

(a) Service Bay

> (i) Saturday and Sunday:

> > Any number of doors could be blocked any Saturday or Sunday between the hours of 06:30 – 15:30. Any door cannot be blocked and the lanes must be clear outside these hours.

(ii) Monday - Friday:

> One door could be blocked Mon. – Fri. day shift between the hours of 06:30 – 16:00 unless Transit is training new staff which would limit these hours. Any door cannot be blocked and the lanes must be clear outside these hours.

(b) Maintenance and Repair Building Bid Opportunity No. 336-2019 Addendum 1 Page 2 of 2

(i) The door cannot be blocked between 06:00 – 08:00 Mon. – Sun. The door can be blocked outside these hours but the contractor shall schedule work to minimize the time the door is blocked.

Add: E3.2 There is no requirement to protect the door openings. Existing doors shall not be

removed until the new doors are on site ready for installation. The Contractor shall schedule work to minimize the duration between removal of existing doors and

installation of new doors.

Add: E3.3 The existing overhead doors in the Service Bay are approximately 12'x12'.

Add: E3.3.1 The Contractor shall confirm the exact door sizes on Site prior to ordering.
