QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1: How many locations does The City of Winnipeg currently have?

A1: WPS (department of The City of Winnipeg) has only one location with seven workstations, on two separate floors.

Q2: Is the current processor Chase Paymentech? If so, is there a preference to keep this vendor?

A2: Yes.

Yes, Chase Paymentech is the current incumbent contractor, as determined by the City of Winnipeg.

Q3: What are the current receipt printers that are supporting the 7 workstations? Is there a desire to keep these or have them replaced?

A3: Reference E5.4: Hardware Cost-Receipt Printers shall be provided by the contractor as part of Item No. 1 on Form B - Prices.

Q4: Does the City of Winnipeg use Active Directory to log in to their Windows workstations?

A4: WPS uses Active Directory to log into the Windows workstations.

Q5: Does the current Point-of-Sale system allow exports of PLU's and employees so they can be imported into a new system?

A5: No. The current amount of unique saleable goods and/or services is currently less than 30, and the number of employees utilizing the cashiering solution is less than 15.

Q6: What version of PeopleSoft does The City of Winnipeg currently use?
