Revise: E20.3.1 to read: Installation shall be in accordance with Manufacturers specifications and in accordance with the most recent Canadian Standards Association Standards within the designated play equipment area on the Drawings.

- (a) Contractor shall use threadlock, per E20.2.4, on all hardware for swing components assembled on site by Contractor, as per Manufacturer's written specifications and instructions.
- (b) Top rail is to be level and posts securing anchored in concrete.
- (c) Swing seats shall not be installed until the protective surfacing, has been installed.

- (a) Holes for concrete footing for play equipment and swings must be inspected and approved by the Contract Administrator prior to installation of concrete. Contractor to provide min. two (2) business days' notice for inspection.
- (b) All concrete footings for play equipment and swing sets shall be in accordance with Manufacturer's specifications. Proponents are to include drawings showing Manufacturer's Footing Specification in their Bid Submission.
- (c) All posts and supports shall be centred in the concrete footing such that there is a complete collar of concrete around each post and support. Where posts are not perfectly centred there should be a minimum of 50 mm (2") concrete at any point around the post.
