#### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Q1: Will freezing temperature pressure testing be allowed if the working ends are hoarded and heated during the entire duration of the pressure test?

A1: If exposed ends are heated, hoarded, and maintained above 5 degrees it is acceptable. Ends must be protected from freezing until backfilled or until temperature stays above freezing.

Q2: What is to be considered an approved anchor system for the directional drill? There are several methods to anchoring but we are not familiar with any having official industry approval.

A2: Means and methods for the Contractor anchoring the rig shall be at the discretion of the Contractor based on their rig and site setup. Anchor shall be suitable to complete drilling activities based on the site conditions.

Q3: Is there a specification outlined for conductor tracer cable to be pulled with the 500mm underneath the river portion?

A3: No tracer cable has been specified for this crossing.
