PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

- Revise: B2.1 to read: The Submission Deadline is 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, September 14, 2023.
- Revise: B8.5 to read: Proponents shall submit a budget estimate for the expenses associated with the following tasks, which shall be excluded from the evaluated Fee Proposal. For Contract Award, an allowance will be added to the evaluated Fee Proposal to cover these costs. Costs for allowances shall be incurred on an actual-cost basis, with proponent-markup of up to 5% for subconsultant handling charges.
- (a) Condition Assessment expenses (D7);
 - (b) Stakeholder Relations expenses (D9.4);
- Add: B8.5.2 For the purposes of the budget estimate for Bridge Condition Assessment expenses, the following should be included in the budget estimate of expenses and excluded from the Total Evaluated Fee Proposal: sample extraction and repair, sample transport, laboratory testing, in-situ material testing, non-destructive testing, delamination survey, defect and crack mapping survey, reinforcing cover survey, and corrosion potential survey.
- Add: B8.5.3 For the purposes of the budget estimate for Stakeholder Relations expenses, the following should be included in the budget estimate of expenses and excluded from the Total Evaluated Fee Proposal: postage, facility rental, food and beverage costs, printing costs, equipment rental, etc.
- Revise: B9.1 to read: Proposals should include details demonstrating the history and experience of the Proponent and Subconsultants in applicable professional consultant services as required in D4.1 as well as possible future phases as noted in **D3.6**, and as defined in Appendix A, for up to three projects of similar scope and complexity and/or similar size and complexity.

- Add: D3.5(d) A 2400 mm land drainage trunk sewer is present in the Plaza Drive West (Public Road) right-of-way, providing land drainage from the Lot 16 Drain to the Red River.
- Add: D8.3(a) (ii) For clarity, the scope of work for Plaza and Pembina intersection is intended to primarily be a geometric exercise and not intended to be a full traffic modelling analysis. If the proposed geometric design results in changes that would potentially impact traffic operations, the City may include traffic modelling analysis as a scope change subsequently.
- Revise: D16.3 to read: The City intends to award this Contract by October 9, 2023.
- Revise: D17.1(a) to read: Complete D7 by December 27, 2023;
- Revise: D17.1(b) to read: Complete D8 by March 7, 2024;
- Revise: D17.1(c) to read: Complete D9 and submit a draft preliminary design report including any property requirements for City review by May 10, 2024; and
- Revise: D17.1(d) to read: Submission of the final preliminary design report by June 7, 2024.
