QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q1: What is the estimate volume of carts generated based on previous years (number, kilos etc. would work)?
- A1: Kindly refer to E2.1.1 and 2.1.2 which indicates 40,000 units for 2024 (30,000 units currently on site and we will receive approx. 10,000 more in 2024) and subsequent years will be 20,000 units.
- Q2: Why not have it shipped to a processor like EFS directly instead of taking on the grinding work yourself?
- A2: The grinding work is to maximize volume in our shipments to processors due to the high quantity of units.
- Q3: If EFS received all carts at end of life (stacked or baled, no metal axles) and processed them, could the City consider purchasing new carts with recycled content? There is an opportunity to close the loop here.
- A3: This is something that would require its own procurement in an open tender process and we are focused on the grinding program at this time.
