Revise: B2.1 to read: The Submission Deadline is 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, May 7, 2025

Revise: B6.5 (b) to read: have a font size to a minimum 12-point Arial or equivalent combination of font and size,

single spaced;

Revise: B6.5 (f) (i) to read: Cover page, cover letter, table of contents, Form P, and Form A shall not count towards

the page limit;

Delete: B10.2 (c) Consultant Representatives

PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: 3.5 (a) (iii) to read: Bison Drive between Frontier Trail and Waverley Street is currently a greenfield corridor.

The RoW has been established as a Major Arterial consistent with the Transportation Standards Manual. The RoW widens as it approaches Waverley Street to facilitate

intersection improvements.

Revise: 3.5 (e) to read: Public Works Department is currently in the process of delivering a renewal of the

Pembina Highway and Abinojii Mikanah overpass. Included in this renewal is a

reconfiguration of the eastbound Abinojii Mikanah to Pembina Highway offramp to align with University Crescent. This realignment will result in some University of Manitoba bound trips diverted from Bison Drive/Chancellor Matheson to University Crescent.
