#### **PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS**

- Add: D2.4 Further to C12.4, if the Province of Manitoba revises the fees under The Highway Traffic Act or other applicable legislation during the Contract, the City will adjust the Citizen Tow rates by the legislated revision.

#### **PART E – SPECIFICATIONS**

- Add: E2.3.2 Flatbed wreckers, dollies, winching shall only be provided for Citizen Tows where required to tow and transport the vehicle to the place of storage. Costs and charges for all Citizen Tows shall be as set out in the Impoundment of Vehicles Fees Regulation, M.R. 243/89 regardless of the police reason of tow.
- Revise E2.4 to read: Item No. 1 - **Tow Light Vehicle (Citizen Tow)**. Towing and transportation of a vehicle having a registered gross vehicle weight of not more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb) from the place of seizure to the place of storage.
- Revise E2.5 to read: Item No. 2 - **Towing Light Vehicle with dolly or flatbed (Citizen Tow)**. Towing and transportation of a vehicle having a registered gross vehicle weight of not more than

4,540 kg (10,000 lb) from the place of seizure to the place of storage. When the use of a dolly or flatbed is required.

- Revise E2.6 to read: Item No. 3 - **Tow Heavy Vehicle (Citizen Tow)**. Towing and transportation of a vehicle having a registered gross vehicle weight of more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb) from the place of seizure to the place of storage.
- Revise E2.7 to read: Item No. 4 – **Towing Heavy Vehicle with dolly or flatbed (Citizen Tow)**. Towing and transportation of a vehicle having a registered gross vehicle weight of more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb) from the place of seizure to the place of storage. When the use of a dolly or flatbed is required.
- Revise E2.8 to read: Item No.5 – **Storage Charges Light Vehicle (Citizen Tow)**. Storage of a vehicle having a registered gross weight of not more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb.).
- Revise E2.9 to read: Item No. 6 – **Storage Charges Heavy Vehicle (Citizen Tow)**. Storage of a vehicle having a registered gross weight of more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb.).
- Revise E2.10 to read: Item No.7 – **Winching (Citizen Tow)**. Fee for winching when a tow is required or when a tow is not required.
- Revise E2.11 to read: Item No.8 – **Towing Light Vehicle (WPS Tow)**. A flat rate per tow for all WPS vehicles with a registered gross vehicle weight of not more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb). Shall include all costs and charges for Towing Light Vehicle (WPS).
- Revise E2.12 to read: Item No.9 – **Towing Heavy Vehicle (WPS Tow)**. A flat rate per tow for all WPS vehicles with a registered gross vehicle weight of more than 4,540 kg (10,000 lb). Shall include all costs and charges for Towing Heavy Vehicle (WPS).
- Revise E2.13 to read: Item No.10 – **Service Call for Boosting (WPS)**. A flat rate for boosting a WPS vehicle.
- Add E2.13.1 Further to E2.13, the Contractor shall provide a flat rate for boosting a vehicle battery (12 /24 Volt) where no other service is required. Where boosting is unsuccessful and towing is therefore required, only the towing charge shall apply.

- Revise E3.9 to read: The Contractor shall, at all times, have available at least two (2) light duty tow trucks, two (2) medium duty tow trucks, two (2) **flatbed** car carriers and one (1) heavy duty tow truck, to perform their responsibilities 24 hours per day and 7 days per week.

- Revise E3.10 to read: The Contractor shall at all times have the following types of a **flatbed** trailer and applicable tractor unit, to perform their responsibilities 24 hours per day and 7 days per week including but not limited to the actual move, disconnection and subsequent reconnection of drive shaft or transmission linkage:
- (a) One (1) ground loading **flatbed** trailer with a minimum gross vehicle weight of eighteen thousand (18,000) kilograms (40,000 lbs.).
  - (b) One (1) ground loading **flatbed** trailer with a minimum gross vehicle weight of thirty-two thousand nine hundred and thirty-one (32,931) kilograms (72,600 lbs.)
- Revise E5.3 to read: The Contractor shall, at all times, have available at a minimum two (2) **flatbed** or car carriers in their fleet:
