The Project will focus on non-market affordable housing and the inclusion of affordable housing in private developments. The Project will explore potential political and market responses to incentives, as well as financial impacts of incentives on different types of development in different areas. Some key tools available as incentives could include: zoning entitlements, **fast-tracking development, reducing or waiving fees**, tax increment financing, grants, and others.
