### **PART C - SCOPE OF SERVICES**

- Add: C1.4.1                      The budget stated in C1.4 is the total approved budget for completing the SRN study. Consulting fees available for completing the scope of services defined in C2 will be further discussed in stage 2 of the procurement process (RFP).
- Clarification of C2.3 (b)(iii):      The SRN Study will not be required to develop an updated Motor Vehicle Noise Policy. The Motor Vehicle Noise Policy is being updated separate from the SRN study. The SRN study will need to provide a high-level discussion about motor vehicle noise impacts and considerations, especially related to widening roadways in existing built-up areas. Typical cross-section drawings will need to consider potential mitigation options (berms or fences).

### **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

- Q1:      For the stakeholder engagement aspect of the work, is the expectation that this will be done through (or in collaboration with) the Office of Public Engagement?
- A1:      The expectation is the consultant team will lead and conduct all aspects of stakeholder engagement.
- Q2:      If the engagement is done in collaboration with OPE, should there not be an additional report included in the list of reports? - A stakeholder outreach and relations report? This is typically a requirement from OPE.
- A2:      C2.2 outlines the high-level tasks involved in stakeholder engagement. As noted in clause C2.2 (iv) and (v), how feedback from stakeholders was considered and how it contributed to outcomes will need to be documented and shared with participants. Further clarity on specific deliverables will be provided in stage 2 of the procurement process (RFP).
