PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

- Add: D12.1 (b) Each project location provided by the City will consider the following criteria:
- (i) Two (2) catch basins (as a pair) to be redirected to a new land drainage sewer extension, which are a maximum 150m from the nearest downstream tie-in sewer.
 - (ii) Up to two (2) locations will be within a collector or arterial street.
 - (iii) Up to four (4) locations will require an LDS connection within a collector street and one (1) location will require an LDS connection within an arterial street. All other locations will be within local residential streets.
 - (iv) No locations will be within close proximity to critical infrastructure such as feeder mains, aqueducts, pump stations, or dikes.
 - (v) No locations will require the crossing of a railway.
 - (vi) No locations will require a Waterways Permit.
- Revise: D12.5(a) to read: Where recommended project locations are determined to be unfeasible after the completion of the Preliminary Design Report, at the sole discretion of the City, the City may request additional project sites to be analysed. The additional work allowance of \$50,000 is to be used for analysis of project locations greater than the twenty sites approved in D12.3 or for sites that do not strictly follow criteria under D12.1 (b). When such work arises, the Consultant shall prepare a concise cost proposal in collaboration with the Consulting Contract Administrator. The proposal shall be submitted to the Consulting Contract Administrator for final approval. No additional work shall start prior to this approval.
