- Add Item No. 9

PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise: B12.3 to read as follows:

- B12.3 The Bidder and/or any proposed Subcontractor (for the portion of the Work proposed to be Subcontracted to them) shall:
- (a) have successfully carried out work similar in nature, scope and value to the Work; and
 - (b) be fully capable of performing the Work required to be in strict accordance with the terms and provisions of the Contract;
 - (c) have a written workplace safety and health program, if required, pursuant to The Workplace Safety and Health Act (Manitoba);
 - (d) have completed the Accessible Customer Service online training required by the Accessibility for Manitobans Act (AMA) (see B12.4 and D5);
 - (e) upon request of the Contract Administrator, provide the Security Clearances as identified in PART F - ; and
 - (f) **have and maintain Manitoba Health Potable Water Certification in compliance with the Manitoba Drinking Water Safety Act.**

PART E – SPECIFICATIONS

Revise: E2.3 to read as follows:

- E2.3 Item No. 1 – Bulk Water – WEPC **Utility Building Site** shall be bulk water supplied and delivered to the West End Water Pollution Control Centre (WEWPCC) on an “as required” basis as follows:
- (a) Utility Building, 7740 Wilkes Avenue;

- (i) **Fill or top up** 2 x 4,000 gallon tanks; and
- (ii) Approximately **thirty-six (36)** deliveries per year.

Delete: E2.3(b) in its entirety.

Add: E2.11 as follows:

- E2.11 Item No. 9 – Bulk Water – WEPCCC Perimeter Road Pumping Station Site (up to 530 gallons) shall be Bulk water supplied and delivered to the West End Water Pollution Control Centre (WEWPCC) on an “as required” basis as follows:
- (a) Perimeter Road Pumping Station, 6821 Wilkes Avenue
 - (i) Fill or top up 1 x 530 (approximately) gallon tank
 - (ii) Approximately twenty-five (25) deliveries per year
 - (iii) With attendance of a City Employee Staff from 7740 Wilkes Avenue
