Winnipeg Transit in partnership with Oshki Annishinabe Nigaaniwak, the City of Winnipeg's Aboriginal Youth Strategy, is hiring and training 8 to 12 Aboriginal Bus Operators!

DID YOU KNOW?

- Winnipeg Transit needs to hire up to 140 new Bus Operators in 2014
- Bus Operators make up to \$24.87 / hour, receive a comprehensive pension and benefits package and accumulate 3 weeks' vacation in their first year of employment
- As part of this initiative you are hired as an employee of Winnipeg Transit and trained as a Bus Operator...guaranteeing your future employment
- Wages are paid throughout the training portion of employment
- Class 2 licence training and testing (including Air Brake endorsement) is paid for by Transit and is done on-site by familiar instructors
- As a Bus Operator, a portion of your driver's licence renewal is paid for by Transit
- Discounts are provided to you for all City of Winnipeg recreation facilities
- All active and retired staff receive free Transit service city-wide
- All required uniforms and safety equipment is provided at no charge to staff

TO QUALIFY YOU MUST...

- Be of Aboriginal decent
- Be between the ages of 18 & 30
- Be able to work a variety of shifts (days, evenings, weekends, splits)
- Successfully complete a medical screening (including drug & alcohol testing)
- Possess a grade 10 education (or higher)
- Possess a satisfactory Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check
- Possess and maintain a valid Class 5 Driver's Licence
- Provide a Driver's Abstract (with a Driver's Safety Rating of +1 or better)
