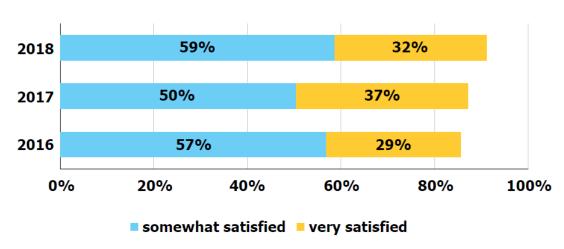


Citizen Satisfaction with Overall City Services

Citizen Satisfaction with Animal Services



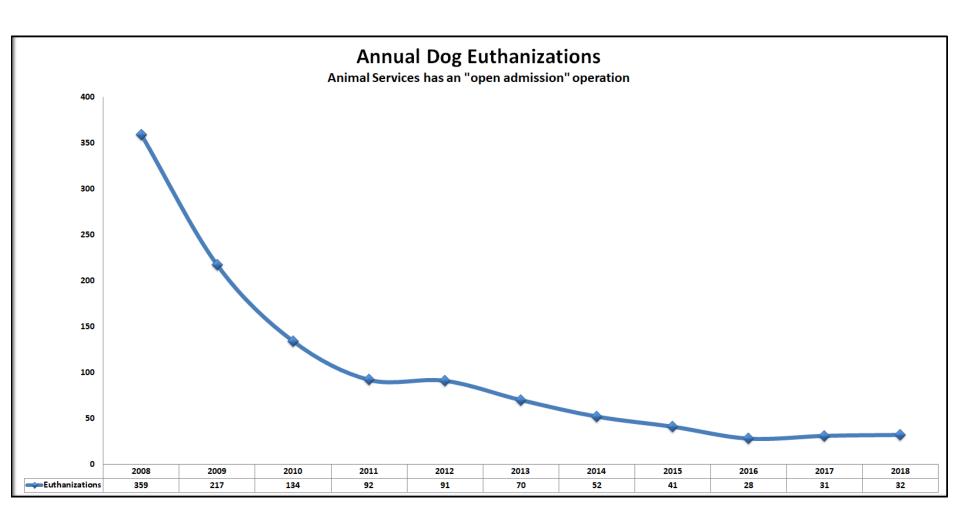
In 2018, 91% of respondents indicated they were satisfied with the provision of animal services.

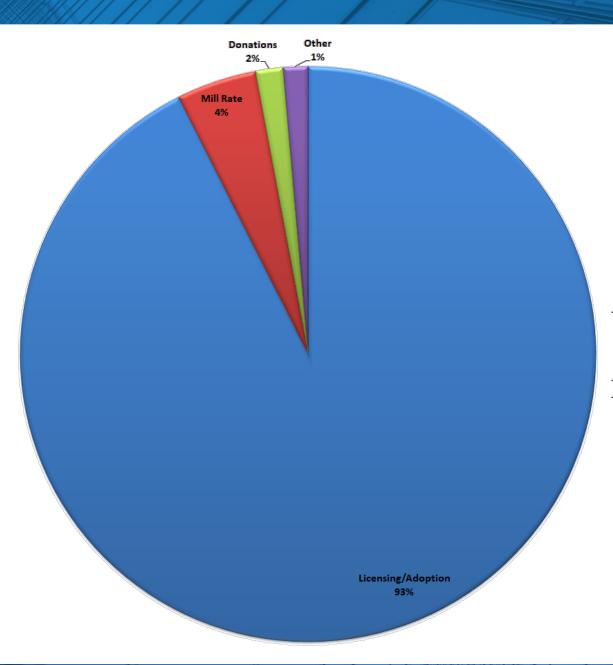

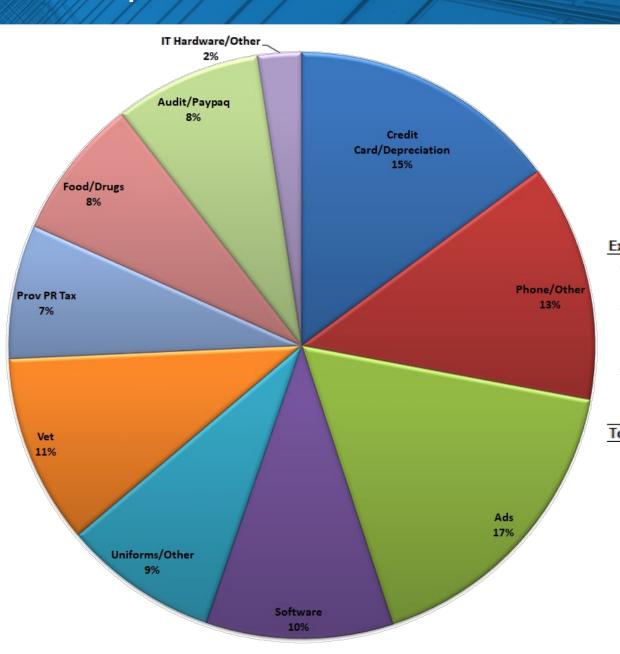

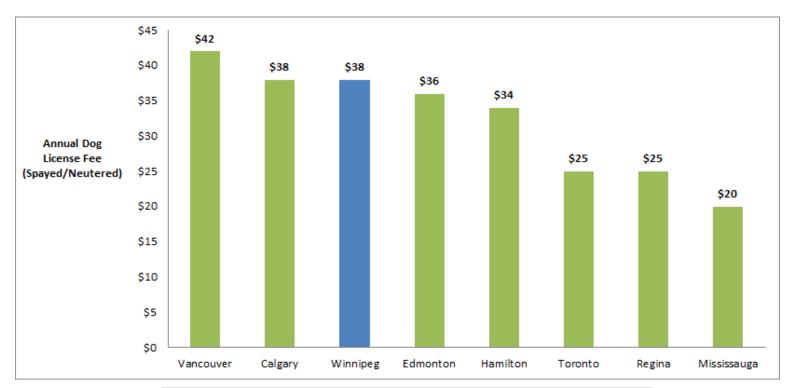

2018 Annual Dog License Fees by Jurisdiction (Spay/Neuter)

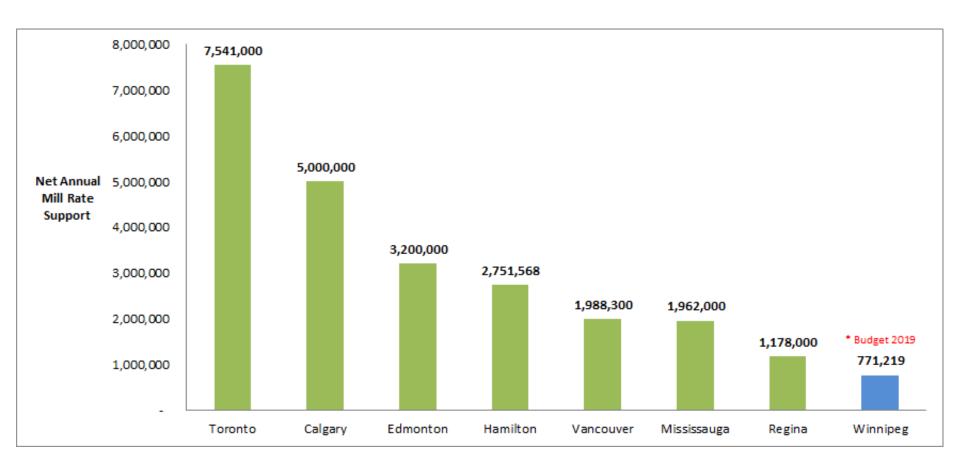

The chart below shows the average employee print charges for the Animal Services Department (\$6.25) compared with other departments. The average employee print charges for all departments combined was \$9.32.

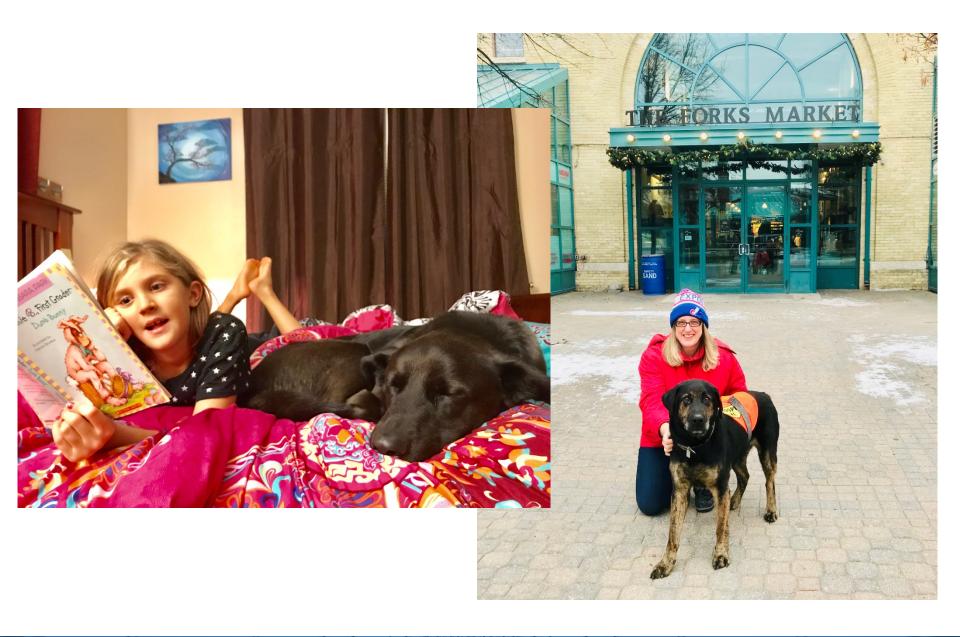
