1	Chair's Update	The Chair welcomed members and reviewed recent events and activities.	
		It was noted that community conversations and calls to action are increasing with the upcoming deadline for the report of the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls. Also, on March 12, 2019 the Manitoba Children's Advocate published a Special Report, 'A Place Where it Feels like Home: The Story of Tina Fontaine'.	
2	Mayor's Update	The Mayor thanked the Elder for her opening prayer and members for their ongoing commitment during a very busy season.	
		In working to build a community that welcomes and protects everyone, the Mayo indicated his support for the five thoughtful and pragmatic recommendations in the latest report of the Manitoba Children's Advocate. The City will collaborate on implementation.	
		Within the national context, Welcoming Winnipeg has been well received as a proactive community process.	
		The Indigenous Accord now has 143 members. The Mayor thanked members for their efforts to date and invited and anticipated continued development and growth.	
		Earlier this year, the Human Rights Committee of Council was established. The Mayor had the honour of chairing its first meeting with the objective of facilitating Winnipeg as an international leader in protecting human rights. More work is needed to align and support existing institutions, groups and organizations within our community. This work will be complementary to initiatives of the Circle and the Mayor will keep members up to date on efforts.
