Homeowner Applicant Plumbing Permit Declaration

To be completed by homeowners performing plumbing work to a single-family dwelling that they own and where they reside, or will reside, as their primary residence.

The City of Winnipeg Building By-Law requires that all plumbing work be performed by a licensed plumbing contractor. In addition, the City licences these plumbers through its plumbing contractor licensing program such that all permit applications for plumbing work in the City of Winnipeg must be submitted by a licensed plumbing contractor. The only exception is for homeowners performing plumbing work to a single-family dwelling that they own and where they reside or will reside as their primary residence.

This Declaration is intended to ensure that homeowner plumbing permits are only issued in compliance with these requirements. In order to qualify for a homeowner plumbing permit, the applicant for such a permit must declare all statements in this Declaration to be true. A false Declaration could result in cancellation of the permit and/or prosecution of the homeowner.

Notwithstanding the above Declaration, the City of Winnipeg recommends that homeowners hire a licensed plumbing contractor to perform plumbing work and shall not be responsible for the safety of any persons or damage to property when homeowners opt to perform plumbing work themselves. As per the current Winnipeg Building By-law, the City of Winnipeg Inspections Branch reserves the right to revoke a permit and demand that a licensed plumbing contractor be retained if the homeowner-applicant has demonstrated that they are not competent to perform the work in a satisfactory code-compliant manner.
