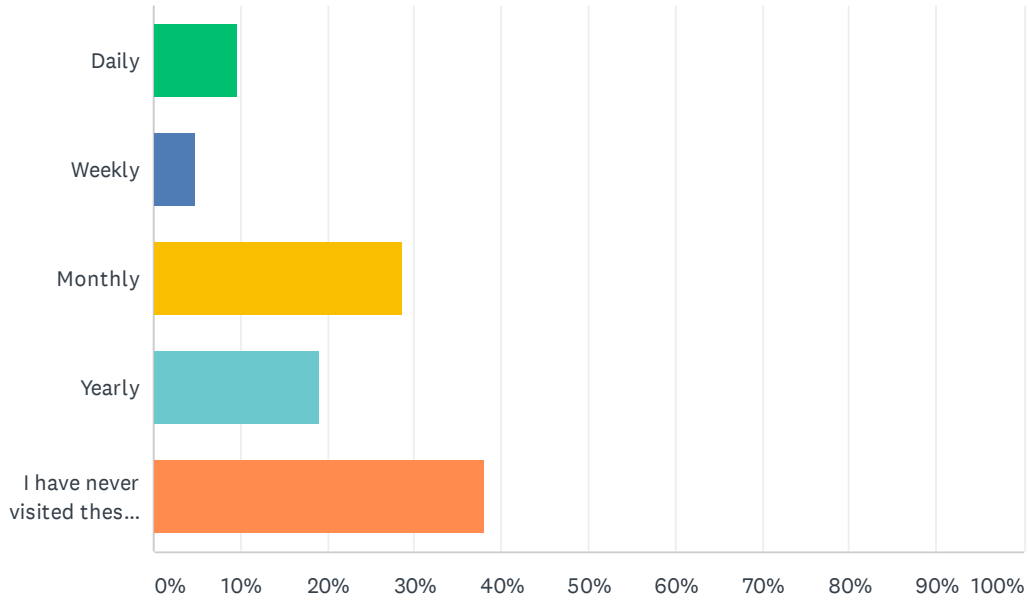


Q1 How often do you visit Blue Bird or Lismore Parks?

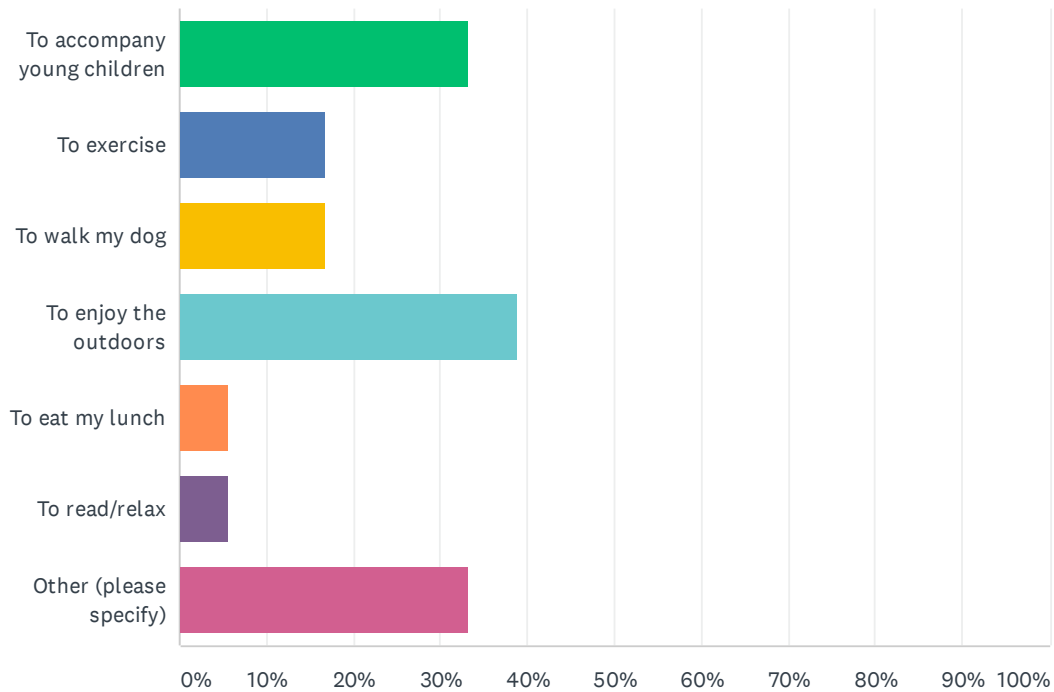

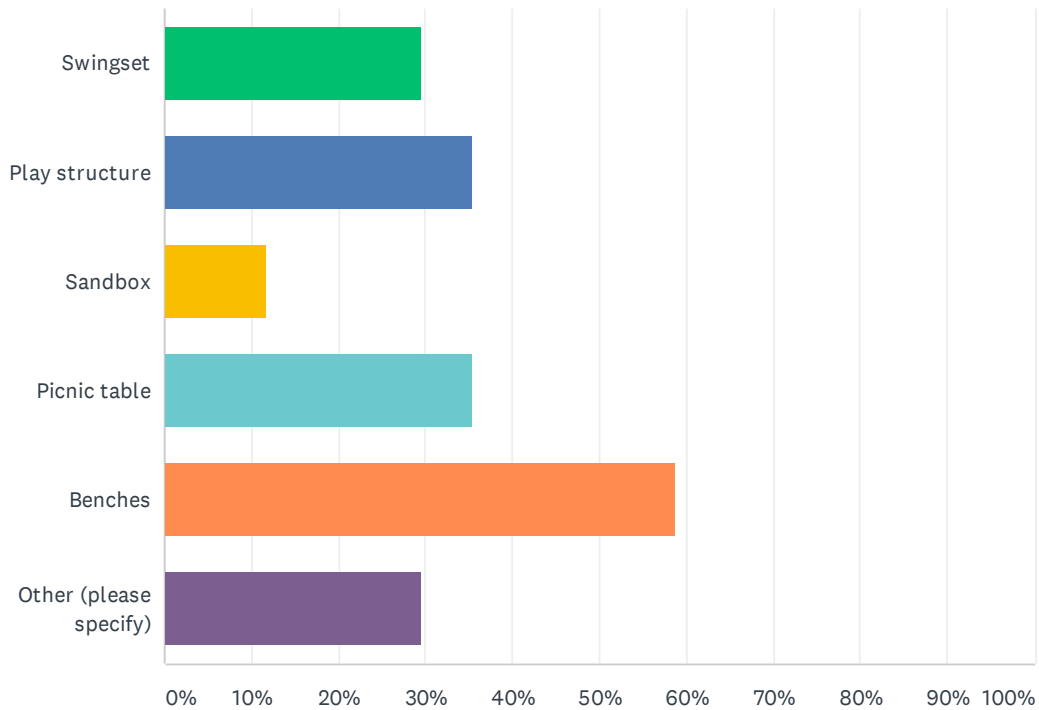

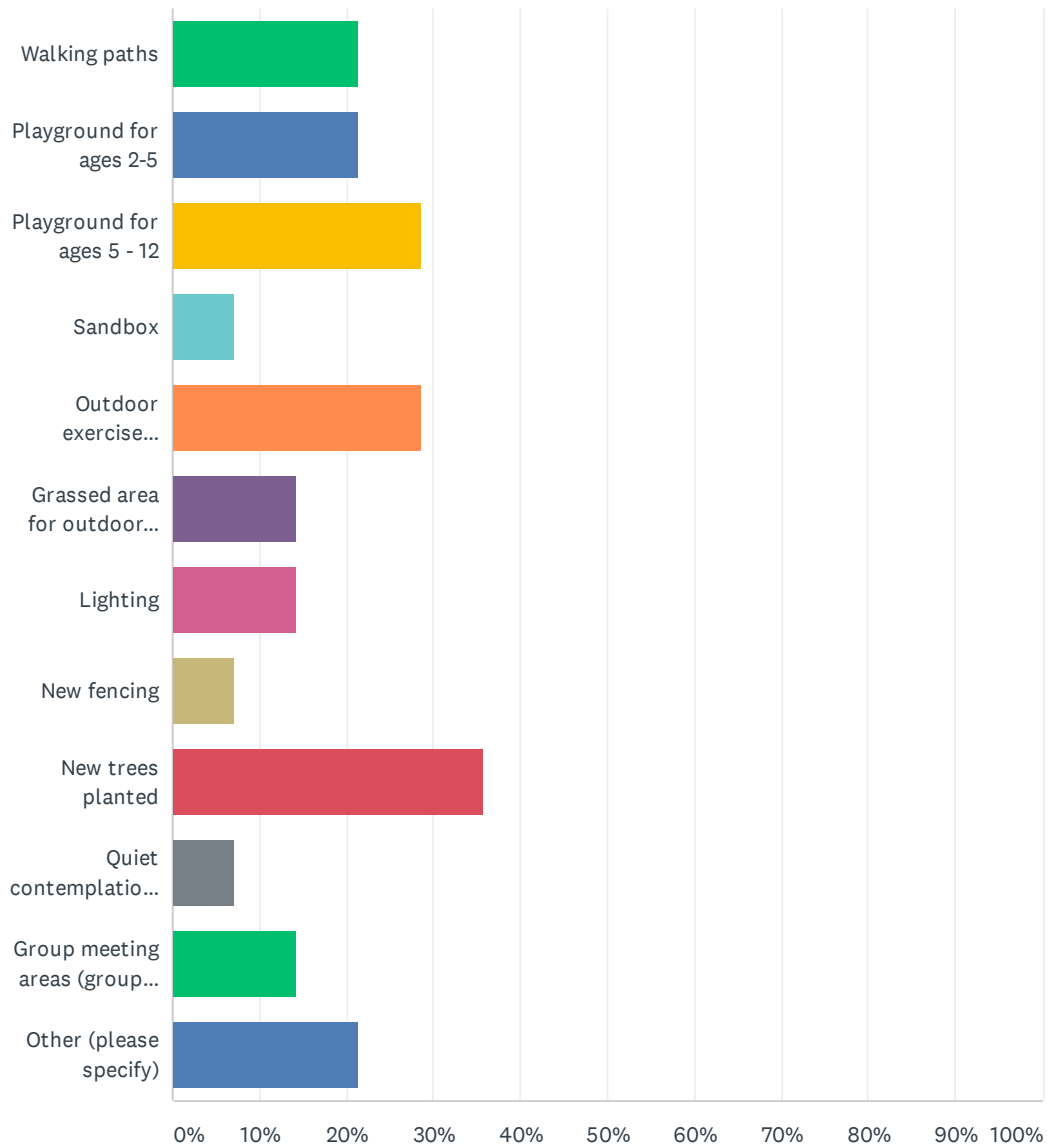

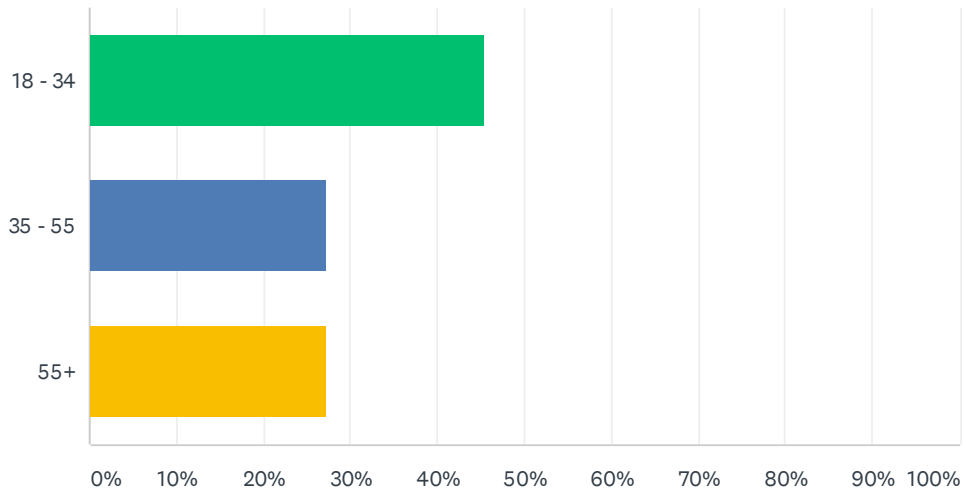

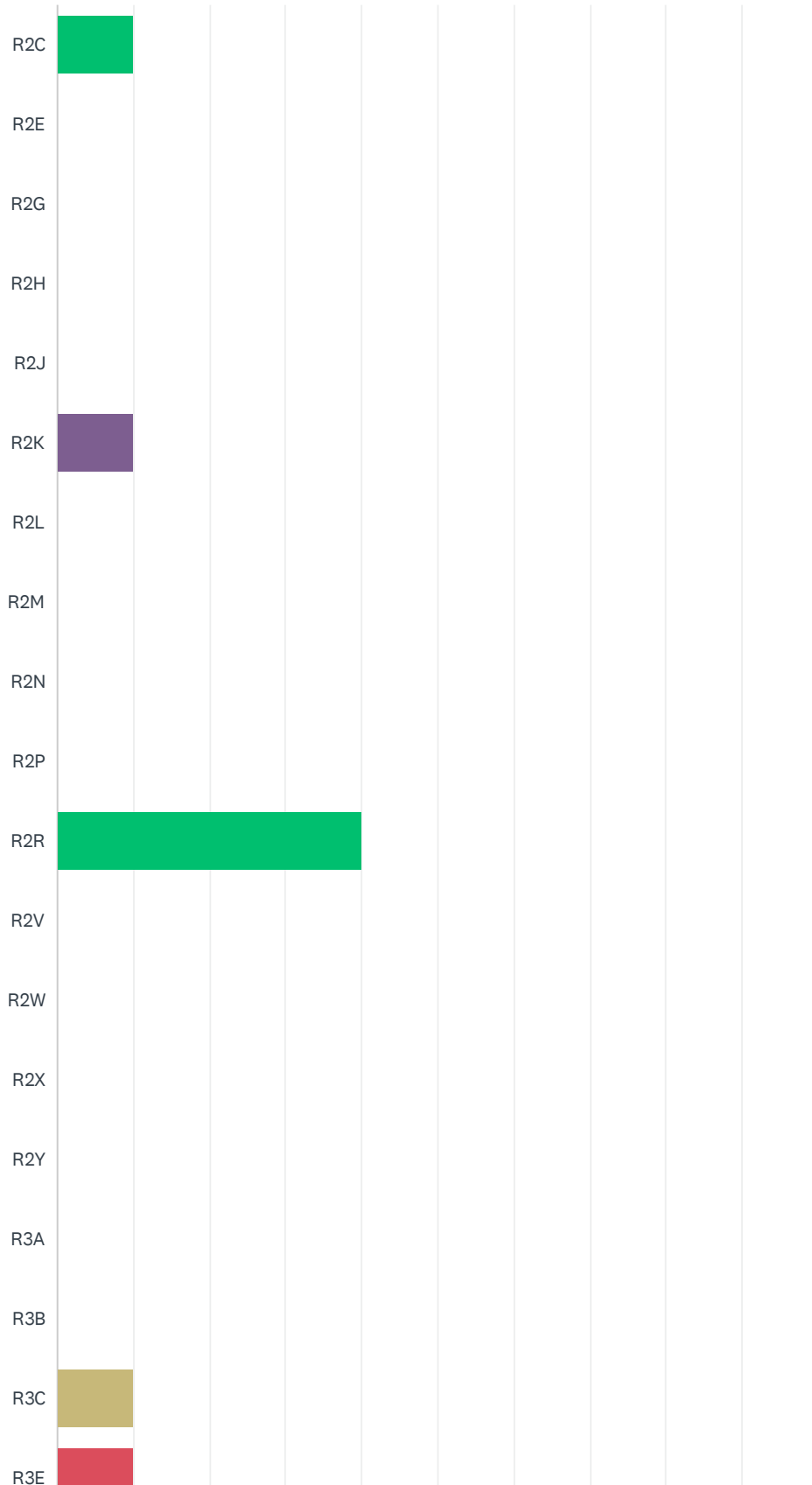

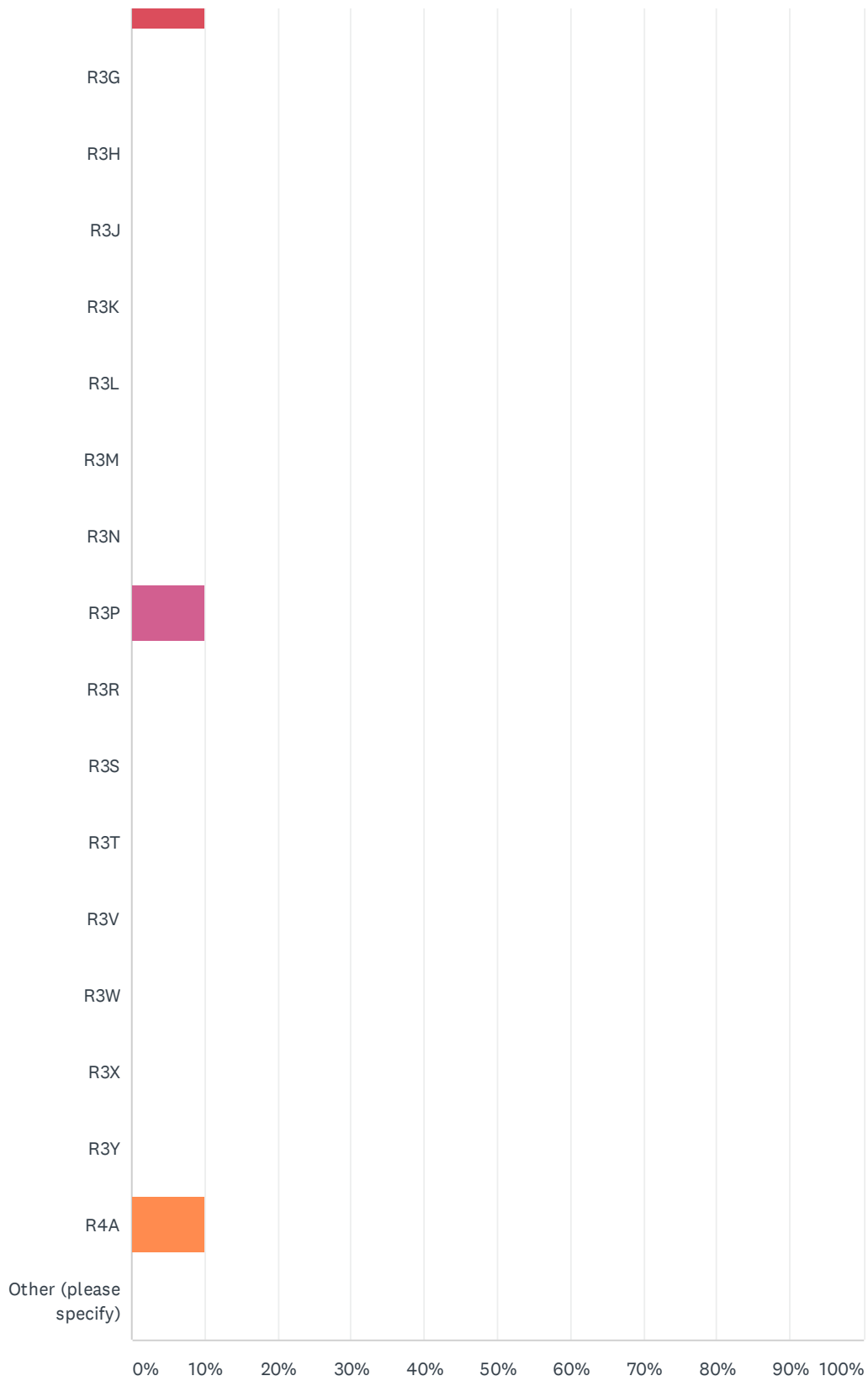
