2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF JARVIS STREET

**RE: 2026 INDUSTRIAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM –
JARVIS AVENUE FROM McPHILLIPS STREET TO PARR STREET**

Please be advised that road construction on Jarvis Avenue will begin soon.

Construction Start Date: Stage 1 – Week of July 6, 2026
Duration: Approximately 4- 5 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Mill the existing asphalt roadway
- Repair and install sewer infrastructure
- Repair damaged pavement, curbs, and sidewalks
- Pave the roadway with asphalt
- Restore boulevards

During construction:

- One lane will be closed to traffic
 - We will maintain east bound traffic at all times
- There will be no on-street parking
- Vehicle access to private approaches will be maintained
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sections of sidewalks will be closed for construction and repair
- Garbage and recycling pick up will continue as scheduled

- Access and delivery requirements
- Planned special events
- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb

NOTE: New topsoil and sod will be placed on the boulevards as part of this project. While the contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
