1st CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF REGENT AVENUE AND MELROSE AVENUE

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
DAY STREET/REGENT AVENUE EAST ALLEY FROM MELROSE AVENUE EAST TO
KATANA STREET**

We are planning road construction on the Day Street/Regent Avenue East/Melrose Avenue East/Kanata Street Alley this summer.

Construction start window: June 19-26, 2026
Duration: Approximately 3 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair the pavement, sidewalk, and curb as required
- Adjust manholes and drainage inlets
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- The alley will be completely closed to all traffic
 - Residents with alley facing garages or parking must park elsewhere
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Melrose Avenue East residents should place their carts on the non-parking sides of Melrose Avenue East
 - Regent Avenue East businesses will have the garbage and recycling collected and disposed of by the construction crew
 - If you require assistance moving bins, contact us for help from the construction crew
 - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
