TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF BROCK STREET

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
BROCK STREET FROM GRANT AVENUE TO MATHERS AVENUE**

We are planning road construction on Brock Street this summer.

Construction start window: July 1, 2026 to July 10, 2026
Duration: Approximately 8 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove existing pavement
- Repair sewer infrastructure and sidewalks
- Rebuild the road structure
- Repave the road with an asphalt pavement
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- Brock Street will be completely closed to all traffic
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Put out your carts as usual
 - If you require assistance moving bins, contact us for help from the construction crew
 - Put your house numbers on your carts so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
