1st CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF CAMPBELL STREET AND CORDOVA STREET

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM -
CAMPBELL STREET/CORDOVA STREET ALLEY FROM CORYDON AVENUE TO
GROSVENOR AVENUE**

We are planning road construction on Campbell Street/Cordova Street Alley this summer.

Construction start window: June 15, 2026 – July 1, 2026
Duration: Approximately 8 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove existing pavement
- Repair sewer infrastructure and sidewalks
- Rebuild the road structure
- Repave the road with an asphalt pavement
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- The construction will be completed in 2 stages
 - Stage 1 – Corydon Ave to 375 Cordova/460 Campbell
 - Stage 2 – 375 Cordova/460 Campbell to Grosvenor Ave
- The stage under construction will be completely closed to all traffic
 - Residents with alley facing garages or parking must park elsewhere
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Residents should place their carts on the non-parking sides of Campbell Street or Cordova Street. Carts should be placed here for the full duration of construction, Stage 1 and 2.
 - If you require assistance moving bins, contact us for help from the construction crew
 - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
