TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF NASSAU STREET SOUTH

RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM - NASSAU STREET FROM BRANDON AVENUE TO MORLEY AVENUE

We are planning road construction on Nassau Street South this summer.

Construction start window: Week of July 20, 2026, to Week of July 27, 2026
Duration: Approximately 8 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove existing pavement
- Repair sewer infrastructure and sidewalks
- Rebuild the road structure
- Repave the road with an asphalt pavement
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- Nassau Street South will be completely closed to all traffic
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Put out your carts as usual
 - The contractor may relocate carts as needed
 - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
