Please be advised the above project is schedule to begin construction this summer.

Construction start window: Week of June 1, 2026
Duration: Approximately 6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Construct new asphalt transportation pathway
- Renew existing sidewalk as needed
- Upgrade the existing street lighting
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Two-way traffic will be maintained on Selkirk Ave.
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - Put out your carts as usual
 - The contractor may relocate carts as needed
 - Put your house number on your bins so our crews can return them to the proper locations if they are moved
