We are planning road construction on Weatherdon Avenue this summer.

Construction start window: Week of August 10, 2026 to Week of August 17, 2026
Duration: Approximately 6 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Remove existing pavement
- Repair sewer infrastructure and sidewalks
- Rebuild the road structure
- Repave the road with an asphalt pavement
- Restore the boulevard and approaches

During construction:

- Weatherdon Avenue will be completely closed to all traffic
- Garbage pickup and recycling days will not change
 - o Put out your carts as usual
