1st CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF ARLINGTON STREET

**RE: 2026 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM - ARLINGTON STREET FROM INKSTER
BOULEVARD TO ENNISKILLEN AVENUE**

We are planning road construction on Arlington Street this summer.

**Construction Start Window: Stage 1 – Inkster Blvd. to McAdam Ave. – May 2026
 Stage 2 – McAdam. Ave to Enniskillen Ave. – July 2026**

**Duration: Stage 1 – Approximately 9-10 weeks, weather permitting
 Stage 2 – Approximately 9-10 weeks, weather permitting**

We will:

- Replace existing sidewalks as required
- Excavate the existing roadway
- Repair and install sewer infrastructure
- Construct new curbs and approaches and pave the roadway with asphalt
- Restore the boulevard

During construction:

- Arlington St.- Stage 1 will be fully closed to traffic, while Stage 2 will remain open
- Arlington St.- Stage 2 will be fully closed to traffic, while Stage 1 will be reopened
- There will be no on-street parking
- There will be no vehicle access to approaches and garages facing Arlington St.
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks will be closed on one side of the street
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
