2nd CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF ARLINGTON STREET

**RE: 2026 REGIONAL AND LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL PROGRAM -
ARLINGTON STREET FROM INKSTER BOULEVARD TO ENNISKILLEN AVENUE**

Please be advised that Stage 1 construction on Arlington Street will soon begin.

**Construction Start Date: Stage 1 – Inkster Blvd. to McAdam Ave.
Week of May 19, 2026**

Duration: Approximately 9-10 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Replace existing sidewalks as required
- Excavate the existing roadway
- Repair and install sewer infrastructure
- Construct new concrete curbs and concrete approaches
- Pave the roadway with asphalt
- Restore the boulevards

During construction:

- Arlington St.- Stage 1 will be fully closed to Traffic
- There will be no on-street parking
- There will be no vehicle access to approaches and garages facing Arlington St.
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties
 - Sidewalks may be closed on one side of the street at a time
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual and Contractor will relocate bins for collection if needed, please mark your address on your bins so they can be returned to the correct address
- Mail delivery to the community mailbox on Arlington St. may be paused while the sidewalk is repaired. You can pick up your mail at the Canada Post Depot or wait until access is restored.
 - Address is 1462 Church Avenue
 - Hours are Monday to Friday - 9:30am to 1:30pm

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb

NOTE: New topsoil and sod may be placed on the boulevard as part of this Project. While the Contractor will maintain the turf for about a month or so, we do not maintain residential boulevards on an ongoing basis.
