MENNO BAY FROM ANTRIM ROAD TO ANTRIM ROAD

Please be advised that construction on Menno Bay from Antrim Road to Antrim Road will begin soon.

Construction Start Date: Week of June 27th, 2022

Duration: Approximately 5 weeks, weather permitting

The work on Menno Bay will include:

- adjustment of manholes/catch basins
- concrete pavement repairs
- curb replacement
- asphalt overlay
- boulevard restoration

Traffic and Access Management

During construction, one lane of local access traffic will be maintained and parking will be removed. Pedestrian access to all residences will be maintained.

Additional Information

Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at the regular times and location. We ask that you continue to place your bins out on collection day.

Those with accessibility needs, moving requirements, underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within six meters (20 feet) of the street curb line or questions about the project, are asked to contact Richard Weibel at 204-805-0104, during regular working hours.
