TO: BUSINESSES / RESIDENTS

RE: 2022 MUNROE AVENUE PAVEMENT AND WATER MAIN RENEWALS -

WATT STREET TO RALEIGH STREET

Please be advised Munroe Avenue from Watt Street to Raleigh Street is scheduled for a pavement and water main renewal project scheduled to begin May 24, 2022.

Construction start: May 24, 2022

Duration: 14 weeks

Impacted Streets and Intersections: Munroe Ave, Watt St, Golspie Street, and Raleigh Street

Munroe Avenue Pavement Renewal

The roadwork will begin the week of May 24, 2022 and will take approximately 14 weeks to complete.

Munroe Ave will be fully reconstructed between Watt St and Raleigh St. The reconstruction will include drainage infrastructure improvements; concrete pavement reconstruction; sidewalk reconstruction; private approach renewals; geometric improvements of the Munroe Avenue/Watt Street intersection; and traffic signal upgrades.

Traffic and Access Management

- Construction will proceed one lane at a time, allowing one lane of eastbound traffic to be maintained for the duration of the project from Watt St to Raleigh St.
 - Phase 1 Reconstruction of eastbound lane
 - Phase 2 Reconstruction of westbound lane
- Parking will not be permitted on Munroe Ave.
- Golspie St intersection will be maintained except for southbound thru traffic.
- Access to private approaches from Munroe Ave will be maintained as much as possible during construction and accommodations, such as working after business hours and working on weekends, will be made to minimize interruptions.
- Sidewalks will be maintained on one side of the street at all times.
- Transit service will be maintained in the eastbound direction; westbound service will be temporarily relocated. Visit <u>winnipegtransit.com</u> for more information.

General notes

- Garbage and recycling collection will continue to be picked up at regular times and locations.
- If you are a business with access, delivery or loading requirements that we have not been made aware of, please contact us to discuss your needs.
- We also ask those with any accessibility concerns, special events, known underground appurtenances, such as sprinklers or lighting cables within 6m of the Watt St curb line, or questions or concerns regarding construction to contact Kelly Groff at 204-259-1527 or Kelly.Groff@wsp.com.
