RE: 2022 Local Street Renewal Project – Active Transportation Pathway along Pandora Avenue

from Wayoata Street to Redonda Street

Please be advised a new Active Transportation pathway, within the boulevard of Pandora Avenue from Wayoata Street to Redonda Street, will soon begin.

Construction start: Week of July 4, 2022

Duration: 6 weeks

Work will include:

- Excavation
- Placement of geotextile
- Placement and compaction of sub-base and base course materials
- Placement of asphaltic pavement
- Topsoil and sod

Some on-street parking may be restricted at times.

Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at regular locations and times. The contractor may relocate bins if required.

Anyone with accessibility needs, moving requirements, planned special events, any underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within 6 metres (20 feet) of the street curb line or any other questions are asked to contact Mark Vogt from WSP Canada Inc. at (204) 477-6650, during regular working hours or by email at Mark.Vogt@wsp.com.
