TO: Residents

RE: 2022 Local Street Renewal Project – Waterford Avenue between Pembina Hwy and Lyon

Street

Please be advised a reconstruction of Waterford Avenue will soon begin.

Construction start: June 15, 2022 (Waterford Avenue from Pembina Hwy to Wicklow Street)

July 4, 2022 (Waterford Avenue from Wicklow Street to Lyon Street)

Duration: 10 weeks

## Work will include:

- Replacement of the entire pavement structure and curbs
- Renewals of sidewalks, private approaches, and boulevards
- Utility and minor underground improvements and renewals

During construction, on-street parking will be prohibited and the road will be closed to all traffic. Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at regular locations and times. The contractor may relocate bins if required.

Anyone with accessibility needs, moving requirements, planned special events, any underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within 6 metres (20 feet) of the street curb line or any other questions are asked to contact Richard Hawkins from WSP Canada Inc. at (204) 477-6650, during regular working hours or by email at Richard.Hawkins@wsp.com.
