RE: 2022 Local Streets Project

Brock Street from Corydon Avenue to Grosvenor Avenue

Please be advised that Brock Street will be closed this summer to accommodate road renewals.

Construction start: Week of July 11, 2022

Approximate Duration: 4 Weeks Impacted streets / intersections: Brock Street

This project will see Brock Street renewed to improve pedestrian access and drainage, and to improve driving/riding conditions. Work will include removing the existing asphalt pavement, repairing select concrete and curbs, completing some underground work, and installing a new asphalt pavement.

The street will be closed to traffic during construction. Garbage collection will continue in the alley.
