CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF PACIFIC AVENUE

**RE: 2022 LOCAL STREET RENEWAL PROGRAM –
PACIFIC AVENUE FROM TECUMSEH STREET TO SHERBOOK STREET**

Further to the notice sent on July 12, 2022:

We are required to change the scope of work on Pacific Avenue from a rehabilitation to reconstruction. **This change will require the street to close completely to traffic.**

Construction start date: Week of August 22, 2022
Duration: Approximately 5 weeks, weather permitting

Work will include:

- Excavation
- Installation of concrete curb and gutter
- Sidewalk renewal as required
- Sewer repairs
- Construction of a new asphalt pavement
- Boulevard restoration as required

Traffic and Access Management

Pacific Avenue will be fully closed to traffic at all times. Parking will be prohibited during construction. Motorists will be required to park their vehicles on a nearby street or back lane as properties allow. Pedestrian access to all residences will be maintained.

Additional Information

Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at the regular times. The contractor will relocate your bins to a central collection location and return the bins when emptied. **We ask that you mark your address on your bins** and continue to place your bins out on collection day.

Those with accessibility needs, moving requirements, underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within six meters (20 feet) of the street curb line or questions about the project, are asked to contact Richard Weibel at 204-805-0104, during regular working hours.

We recognize that this project will cause some inconvenience and disruption and we thank you for your understanding and patience during construction.

This notice is to advise of changes to the access plan for residents and businesses on Pacific Avenue.

Traffic and Access Management
