RE: 2022 Streets Maintenance Preservation Project:
Eastbound Chief Peguis Trail – Main Street to Henderson Highway

Please be advised the above project will soon begin.

Construction start: Late August 2022
Duration: 8 weeks

The existing pavement on eastbound Chief Peguis Trail will be repaired to address deterioration in the roadway. During construction, traffic will at times be reduced to one lane; however, we will be working in stages to minimize disruptions and the directly impacted area. Access to side streets and private properties, as well as pedestrian access will be maintained.
