TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF NOTRE DAME AVENUE FROM ARLINGTON STREET TO MCPHILLIPS STREET (NORTHSIDE)

RE: 2022 REGIONAL & LOCAL SIDEWALK RENEWALS AND ASSOCIATED WORKS

Please be advised that construction of the north sidewalk on Notre Dame Avenue from Arlington Street to McPhillips Street will begin soon.

Construction Start:	Week of September 5 th , 2022
Duration:	Approximately 3-4 weeks, weather permitting

The work on Notre Dame Avenue will include:

- Concrete curb and sidewalk renewal
- MMA banding for the visually impaired
- New curb ramps and;
- Boulevard restoration where required.

Traffic and Access Management

A minimum two lanes of westbound traffic will be maintained throughout construction during peak traffic hours. On-street parking will be removed during construction. We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties.

Additional Information

Those with accessibility needs, moving requirements, underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within six meters (20 feet) of the street curb line or questions about the project, are asked to contact Erik Hansen at 204-918-4367, during regular working hours.
