CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Residents & Businesses
RE: 2022 Streets Maintenance Preservation Project:
Eastbound Portage Avenue – 50m east of Lake Street to 2510 Portage Avenue,
Northbound Moray Street – William Clement Bridge to Portage Avenue

Please be advised the above project will soon begin.

Construction start: Mid July 2022
Duration: 10 weeks

The existing pavement sidewalk, and curbs on eastbound Portage Avenue / Northbound Moray Street will be repaired to address deterioration in the roadway. The pavement will be diamond grinded for a smoother ride, During construction, traffic on eastbound Portage will be reduced to two lanes, while northbound Moray will be reduced to one lane. We will be working in stages to minimize disruptions and the directly impacted area. Access to side streets and private properties, as well as pedestrian access and garbage and recycling pick-up will be maintained.

Parking will not be permitted on eastbound Portage Avenue within the project area for the duration of the project. Parking on side streets will be maintained.
