TO: Residents & Businesses
RE: 2022 Streets Maintenance Preservation Project: Northbound St. Anne's Road – 90m south of Novavista Drive to 220m north of Meadowood Drive (Domo)

Please be advised the above project will soon begin.

Construction start: Mid-August 2022
Duration: 6 weeks

The existing pavement on northbound St. Anne's Road will be repaired to address deterioration in the roadway. The pavement on St. Anne's Road will be milled down and resurfaced with new asphalt. The work will also include curb repairs and portions of the sidewalk on the east side of St. Anne's Road will be replaced.

During construction, northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane; however, we will be working in stages to minimize disruptions and the length of directly impacted area. Access to side streets and private properties, as well as pedestrian access and garbage and recycling pick up throughout the project limits will be maintained.
