TO: Residents

RE: 2022 Local Street Renewal Project – Victoria Avenue E – Roanoke Street to Leola Street

Please be advised a reconstruction of Victoria Avenue E will soon begin.

Construction start: Approximately September 1, 2022

Duration: 6 weeks

Work will include:

- Sidewalk renewal
- Utility and underground infrastructure repairs and adjustments
- Reconstruction of the street with concrete curb and asphalt pavement

During construction, the street will be completely closed to traffic and private approaches will not be accessible. Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at regular locations and times. The contractor may relocate bins if required.

Anyone with accessibility needs, moving requirements, planned special events, any underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within 6 metres (20 feet) of the street curb line or any other questions are asked to contact Mark Vogt from WSP Canada Inc. at (204) 477-6650, during regular working hours or by email at Mark.Vogt@wsp.com.
