UNIVERSITY CRESCENT FROM THATCHER DRIVE TO PEMBINA HIGHWAY

NORTHBOUND PAVEMENT RECONSTRUCTION SOUTHBOUND PAVEMENT REHABILITATION

Due to weather conditions, construction on University Crescent from Thatcher Drive to Pembina Highway will end soon for the 2022 season.

Remaining work consists of the following and will be completed in Spring/Early Summer 2023:

- Pathway and sidewalk works on the east side of University Crescent from #30 University Crescent to Pembina Highway.
- Concrete pavement works on the east side of University Crescent at Pembina Hwy.
- Pavement rehabilitation of the southbound lanes of University Crescent from Thatcher Drive to Pembina Highway, including concrete pavement repairs, curb and sidewalk renewal and asphalt resurfacing.
- Landscaping on the east and west sides of University Crescent.
