Please be advised that construction on Alwood Crescent will soon begin.

As part of this work we will:

- Mill and repair existing asphalt
- Adjust manholes and catch basins
- Renew the curb and sidewalk
- Restore the boulevard
- Place an asphalt overlay

During construction:

- One lane of two-way traffic will be maintained
 - Periodic short-term full closures will be required
- On-street parking will be removed
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained
- Garbage and recycling will continue as scheduled
 - Please place your bins as usual
 - o Crews will move and return them as required

We recognize that this project will cause some inconvenience and disruption and we thank you for your understanding and patience during construction.

- Accessibility needs, moving requirements, underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within six meters (20 feet) of the street curb line
